Sole Source Certification Award Details

Regarding Information Technology Services (ITS) Sole Source Certification Number 4132 to continue NetTutor® online tutoring services for the Mississippi Community College Board (MCCB) - Mississippi Virtual Community College (MSVCC), please be advised that ITS intends to award to Link-Systems International, Inc. as the sole source provider through July 31, 2022. For an explanation regarding Mississippi state law, policy and procedures for sole source procurements, refer to Attachment C: Sole Source Procurement Overview.

Sole Source Criteria

 The product or services being purchased must perform a function for which no other product or source of services exist:

MSVCC has a current contract with Link-Systems International, Inc. to provide online tutoring services. This certification is to extend the contract for three years to allow more time for MCCB to use pre-purchased hours. NetTutor's online tutoring service allows each institution to customize every aspect of the service their students will receive by specifying the Rules of Engagement. The majority of tutors hold advanced degrees in their subject specialties. Tutors must successfully complete a month-long training period that focuses, in particular, on the educational and technical challenges that differentiate online tutoring from inperson tutoring. NetTutor offers online tutoring 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year (including holidays). The Customer's Sole Source Certification Request is included as Attachment A.

2. The purchaser must be able to show specific business objectives that can be met only through the unique product or services:

MSVCC students have access to live tutoring support 24/7/365 in all math subjects, first year experience and college student success, English and writing. MSVCC uses NetTutor to provide online tutoring services to students in math, science, English, business and economics, humanities, information technology, nursing, and allied health. MSVCC customizes online tutoring offered to students through "rules of engagement" (ROE) established with each college. The ROE allows each college to tailor online tutoring services to its students' unique needs. The Customer's Sole Source Certification Request is included as Attachment A.

3. The product or services must be available only from the manufacturer and not through resellers who could submit competitive pricing for the product or services:

Link-Systems, International, Inc. has certified they are the sole and exclusive provider of NetTutor® online tutoring services and the Refer Tutor Report (RTR) module. The vendor's sole source certification letter is included as Attachment B.

4. Explain why the amount to be expended for the services is reasonable:

An internet search of hourly rates for comparable tutoring providers indicated rates between \$13.00 and \$45.00. The hourly rate paid to Link-Systems is \$26.00 per hour.

MSVCC has worked with Link-Systems to maintain the same hourly rate originally quoted in 2013.

Project Details

Mississippi Virtual Community College implemented Link-Systems NetTutor® Online Tutoring services in 2013 via sole source to provide three years of customized online tutoring services with the ability to co-create the Rules of Engagement at each of the fifteen community and junior colleges. MSVCC uses NetTutor® to provide online tutoring services 24/7/365 to students in math, science, English, business and economics, humanities, information technology (IT), nursing, and allied health. All subject areas, including IT, nursing, and allied health, need to have the same per hour cost to MSVCC. Tutoring needs to be provided for both live, drop-in tutoring and essay review services for MSVCC students.

In 2015, MSVCC added the Refer Tutor Report module as an additional tool to further empower their faculty and staff to communicate focused tutoring objectives and generate relevant reports. MSVCC offers NetTutor® as a comprehensive package of live 24/7 drop-in tutoring for online system students, and NetTutor® with RTR has the ability for instructors/staff to refer

developmental students to NetTutor® online tutoring and identify the exact remediation needed. In 2016, MSVCC added 5,832 hours of planned tutoring services. The purpose of this letter is to certify NetTutor® as the sole and exclusive provider of specific online tutoring services and the Refer Tutor Report (RTR) module.

NetTutor Service Overview

The acquisition of information technology for all state agencies and institutions of higher learning (IHLs) is within the scope of the ITS law, found in Mississippi Code Section 25-53-1, et seq., and the policies and procedures established in accordance with this statute, found in the ITS Procurement Handbook posted on the ITS website (www.its.ms.gov).

ITS enabling legislation requires that information technology hardware, software and services be acquired in a manner that insures the maximum of competition among all manufacturers and suppliers of such equipment and services. Accordingly, ITS promotes full and open competition through the issuance of open specifications and the objective evaluation of Interested Party proposals to determine the lowest and best offering to meet an agency's or public university's business requirements. True competition protects the integrity and credibility of purchasing in the public sector and is essential in providing best value and adequate contractual protection for the purchasing entity. In certain limited situations, information technology acquisitions may be sole-sourced.

ITS utilizes the provisions of Public Purchasing Law for Sole Source and Emergency procurements of information technology. Mississippi Public Purchasing Law (Mississippi Code Section 31-7-13) specifies that noncompetitive items available from one source only be exempted from bid requirements (sole-sourced). ITS statute, in Section 25-53-5 (p), permits ITS to utilize provisions in Public Purchasing Law or regulations, when applicable.

Per Public Purchasing law, acquisitions must meet the following criteria to be authorized as sole source:

- 1. The product or services being purchased must perform a function for which no other product or source of services exists,
- 2. The purchaser must be able to show specific business objectives that can be met only through the unique product or services, AND
- 3. The product or services must be available only from the manufacturer and NOT through resellers who could submit competitive pricing for the product or services. The vendor's correspondence regarding this criterion for this project is included as Attachment B.

By policy as documented in the ITS Procurement Handbook, acquisitions of IT services must include the following information to be authorized as sole source:

- 1. An explanation about why the amount to be expended is reasonable, and
- 2. An explanation regarding the efforts by the purchaser to obtain the best possible price.

For state agencies, approval of all technology purchases with a lifecycle cost of \$5,000 or less, including sole source purchases, has been delegated to the agency. The ITS Procurement Limits Policies for Agencies (a section in the ITS Procurement Handbook) require a minimum of two competitive written bids or proposals for technology purchases with a lifecycle cost over \$5,000 but not over \$50,000 (not over \$25,000 for projects funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act). Since, for single source items, the procuring agency will be unable to obtain two written bids, ITS must certify all sole source acquisitions of information technology with a lifecycle cost greater than \$5,000.

Institutions of Higher Learning (IHLs) or public universities have been delegated the authority to certify sole source procurements up to \$250,000 lifecycle cost under the ITS Procurement Limits Policies for IHLs (a section in the ITS Procurement Handbook). For the certification of sole source procurements delegated to the ClOs at public universities, the public university must follow ITS' Sole Source Procedure, including advertisement of the intent to award as sole source. Institutions certifying a sole source purchase must ensure the criteria listed above are met and documented in writing by the institution and the Interested Party prior to certifying a product or service as sole source. Sole source documentation must be reviewed and approved by the IHL's ClO for any sole-source certification above \$5,000. All sole source documentation should be retained in the public university's procurement file. Sole source requests above \$250,000 lifecycle cost require ITS approval.

Attachment C: Sole Source Procurement Overview

Other than the delegations outlined above, all sole source technology procurements must be certified by ITS. The customer's Sole Source Certification Request for this project is included as Attachment A.

ITS thoroughly reviews Sole Source Certification Requests, determining if competing products and/or services exist. If so, ITS conducts a competitive procurement. If ITS' review confirms the sole source, then a Sole Source advertisement is issued, giving other Interested Parties an opportunity to identify competing products and/or services. Based upon the results of the Sole Source advertisement, ITS will either certify the request as a sole source or conduct a competitive procurement.
