4. General Information, Item 28.2 (Page 6) is being amended as follows:

This document may be delivered by hand, mail, e-mail, or fax. Address information is given on page one of this IFB. The fax number is (601) 713-6380. ITS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DELAYS IN THE DELIVERY OF QUESTION DOCUMENTS. It is solely the responsibility of the Bidder that the clarification document reaches ITS on time. Bidders may contact LaTonya Kirkland to verify the receipt of their document. Documents received after the deadline will be rejected.

5. General Information, Item 28.4 (Page 6) is being amended as follows:

28.4 All potential vendors who would like a site visit to view the existing systems please share what you are anticipating during the visit to ensure MDWFP is prepared. Please send this information to LaTonya Kirkland during the questions period of the bid process, which ends Tuesday, August 2, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. Central Time. A site visit is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, August 11, 2022.

The following questions were submitted to ITS and are being presented as they were submitted, except to remove any reference to a specific vendor. This information should assist you in formulating your response.

- Question 1: I was wondering if you know what contractors had access to the plans, or who normally bids on it. While we do the cameras, we do not offer the access control that is being asked for. I guess I wanted to see what contractors were going to bid on this, as we are a very large axis camera dealer.
- Response: The original Turnkey Agreement with United Automation LLC expired on December 31, 2021, as they no longer provide service to the Mississippi area, and this procurement will replace what was originally contracted for.
- **Question 2:** I would like to make site visits to all locations involved with this bid. During these site visits, I would like to be able to see any servers and inventory the cameras and access doors to determine their condition and verify makes and models. This information will be vital in order to determine an accurate bid on a maintenance agreement. I see on the bid form that you have 8/11 as a tentative site visit but these visits will take more than one day. I could do all the Jackson area offices in one day but the others would have to be different days due to the travel. Is that something we can arrange? If so, I would like to start looking at them next week.
