2. Title page, third box is modified as follows:

3. Section VII Technical Specifications, Item 2 Procurement Project Schedule is amended as follows:

Vendor must include in their proposal a response to each amended requirement as listed above. Vendor must respond using the same terminology as provided in the original requirements.

The following questions were submitted to ITS prior to the submission deadline but were inadvertently omitted from the original RFP Questions and Clarification Memo dated March 4, 2024. The following questions are being presented as they were submitted, except to remove any reference to a specific vendor. This information should assist you in formulating your response.

Question 1: Attachment A: General, Procurement Goals and Objectives, Page 1, Item 10: Can ITS/ASU confirm that Switches and Camera components must be new, from the Manufacturer or Authorized Manufacturer Distributors, and that no gray market or 3rd party substitutions will be accepted?

Response: ASU can confirm all networking equipment must be new equipment.

Question 2: Attachment A, Functional/Technical Requirements, General Requirements, Page 3, Items 31 & 33: Does ASU have a preferred model of these Cisco Switches?

Response: ASU does not have a preferred model. The only requirement is that the proposed unit fulfills the power, management capabilities, and 10g fiber uplinks.

Question 3: Attachment A, Functional/Technical Requirements, General Requirements, Page 3, Items 31 & 33: Does ASU prefer a 24 Port or 48 Port switch?

Response: ASU is only requiring switches with enough ports to support the new and existing camaras proposed for that location.

Question 4: Attachment A, Camera Requirements and Specifications, POE + Network Switch Infrastructure, Hardware, Item F, Page 11: Will ASU provide the SFP+ modules for the switch or is that to be included by the vendor?

Response: SFP+ modules should be included.

Question 5: Attachment A, System Administration and Security, State of Mississippi Enterprise Cloud and Offsite Security Hosting Policy, Item 151, Page 17: Is a proof of partnership with all manufacturers required?

Response: ASU does not require partnership with all manufacturers proposed. However, this is a plus.
